


# Tri-CED Buy Back Center Rules

## 1. Daily CRV Load Limits

To comply with California law, Tri-CED Community Recycling enforces the following daily load limits:


- **100 lbs** of Aluminum
- **100 lbs** of Plastics (#1-7)
- **2,000 lbs** of Glass (all colors combined)
- **50 lbs** of Bag-in-a-Box

 **Loads exceeding these limits will be denied.** A load is defined as all material in one vehicle. **We cannot accept any portion of an overloaded load—the entire load will be turned away.**

## 2. Redemption Methods

- Customers may choose to be paid **by count** for up to **50 CRV beverage containers per material type per transaction** (50 glass, 50 aluminum, and 50 plastic).
- Otherwise, payment will be determined **by weight**.

## 3. Container Condition

 **Accepted:** Only **clean, empty, and whole** containers with **no dirt, excessive liquid, or foreign substances**.

 **Not Accepted:** Dirty, contaminated, or broken containers.

## 4. CRV-Eligible Materials Only

- Payment is only provided for **California Redemption Value (CRV) beverage containers**.
- **Non-CRV materials must be removed** from your load. If non-CRV materials are found, your load may be rejected.

## 5. CRV Label Requirement

- All containers **must have the CRV label attached** to be eligible for redemption.
- Crushed containers are acceptable **only if the CRV label is clearly visible**.

## 6. Out-of-State Vehicles

- Vehicles with **out-of-state license plates** are limited to **\$50 in CRV redemption** per visit.
- **Driver's license information is required**.

## 7. Receipts & Transactions

- **Only one receipt per vehicle**—we cannot split receipts.

- **Review your receipt before leaving. All transactions are final upon receipt.**

## 8. Facility Conduct & Rules

### **Customers must:**

- Be **fully clothed** and conduct themselves **respectfully**.
- **Sort and separate** all containers by type **before entering the facility**.
- **Take all plastic bags** away with them—we do **not** dispose of them onsite.
- Follow all **safety and traffic guidelines**—do not block driveways or impede work vehicles.

### **Prohibited:**

- Loitering—customers must **redeem materials and leave**.
- Being on the premises **outside of Buy Back operational hours** (Tues-Sat, **9:00 AM - 4:30 PM**).
- **Pouring any liquids** onto the ground—including water. Use the **designated liquid disposal drum** in the sorting area.

## 9. Right to Refuse Service

Tri-CED Recycling **reserves the right to refuse service** to any customer who does not comply with these rules.
